## Scholarship Qualifications for APCO Area Scholarship

(Revised March 2003)

The Academy of Pharmacy of Central Ohio (APCO) may annually award up to three (3) \$1000 scholarships to students attending Colleges of Pharmacy, and who either graduated from a high school located in or whose permanent address is in the seven county ( Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Madison, Morrow, Pickaway, and Union) area served by APCO.

Two (2) of these scholarships may be given to students attending The Ohio State University where APCO maintains an endowment. A third scholarship may be given to a student attending any other College of Pharmacy. The scholarship is funded by the proceeds from APCO's Annual Scholarship Raffle and other designated fundraisers.

1. Scholarship applications for the 2010-2011 academic year shall be submitted to the APCO Scholarship Committee by April 30, 2010

3. Acknowledgements of the receipt of all applications will be made by email.

4. All applications shall be reviewed by the APCO Scholarship Committee to verify that eligibility criteria have been met.

5. Applicants shall be enrolled as full-time students in accredited Colleges of Pharmacy.

6. Applicants shall be in good standing within their College of Pharmacy.

7. Selection of recipients shall be based on, but not limited to, scholastic achievement and financial need.

8. Applicants should show interest in extra-curricular pharmacy associations, such as the Academy of Student Pharmacists.

9. Applicants shall be accepted from the members of any college class. However, preference will be given to upper-class students having at least three quarters or two semesters until their graduation.

10. Special consideration shall be given to those applicants who indicate a preference for the practice of community pharmacy.

11. The scholarship is not renewable, but it may be awarded to the same student more than once.

12. Letters of endorsement from any APCO member are welcome and will be considered.

13. Final selection of recipients will be at the sole discretion of the Scholarship Committee.

14. Successful Applicants for 2010-2011 will be notified by mail before May 31, 2010.

15. Upon receipt of a copy of the paid fee statement from the recipient for the start of the Fall 2010 quarter/semester, APCO shall issue the appropriate paperwork to either the recipient or their College of Pharmacy, whichever is consistent with their College's policy.

16. The scholarship recipient shall serve as a non-voting member of the APCO Executive Committee for a period of one year. APCO desires that the recipient will attend monthly Membership Meetings. The dates and times of those meetings will be published in APCO mailings and on the APCO web page.

17. APCO would like to present a scholarship certificate to each recipient at its Annual Family Golf Outing and Scholarship Raffle in either August or September 2010. There is no cost (with the exception of playing golf) to either the recipient or their guest to attend the event.

18. APCO would like to recognize all of the scholarship recipients at its Annual Officer Installation and Recognitions Dinner held in the Columbus area in late April or early May, 2010. There is no cost to either the 2010-2011 recipient or their guest to attend the event.

**The Colleges of Pharmacy of the selected recipients are encouraged to cooperate with APCO by publicizing the scholarships and reminding the recipients about APCO's desires and expectations.**
